## 5 days 4 nights Programme

**Day 1** - Arrive Sandakan, transfer to Batu Puteh, a village near the lower Kinabatangan river. *Activities: Briefing and river cruise. Overnight accommodation throughout this programme will be at a homestay. (Dinner)*

**Day 2** - Floodplain Forests Introduction & Restoration Site Preparation. *Activities: Interpretive forest nature walk, seed collection, site preparation for tree planting, mapping of restoration site and river cruise for wildlife observation. (Fullboard)*

**Day 3 & 4** - Floodplain Forests & Restoration *Activities: Wildlife observation, working at a nursery to plant seeds in germination beds and tree planting at forest restoration site. (Fullboard)*

**Day 5** - Depart Batu Puteh for Sepilok Orang Utan Rehabilitation Centre. *Activities: Learning about Orang Utan rehabilitation programme. (Breakfast, Lunch)*
